MEMORANDUM ORDER

SHADUR, Senior District Judge.

*1 This Court has received a belated request by Vernon Ingram ("Ingram") to be included in the class of Stateville Correctional Center ("Stateville") inmates who are

entitled to participate in the benefits of the Class Action Settlement Agreement previously approved by this Court in this action. That class comprises inmates who were assigned to Category 1 or Category 2 protective custody at Stateville at any time between April 30, 1982 and May 31, 1989.

Upon receipt of Ingram's request this Court directed the request to class counsel so that they could investigate the factual situation to determine whether Ingram was indeed a member of the class entitled to participate. Class counsel have now reported the results of that investigation (including their having had a telephone conversation with Ingram, as well as having reviewed the records of the Illinois Department of Corrections).

Those Department records reflect that Ingram was confined to and released from protective custody at Stateville *before* April 30, 1982. Ingram had no information or documentation to the contrary, and accordingly this Court denies his motion.
