Wexford explained the process for referring inmate patients for audiological evaluations as follows: (1) once an inmate seeks a hearing screening, a nurse uses an audio scope to perform an initial hearing test; (2) the audio scope test involves three different frequencies and a single noise level; (3) the nurse administering the screening test notes whether the inmate patient is able to hear all three frequencies in each ear; (4) if the inmate patient is unable to hear even one frequency, the patient is deemed to have failed the test; (5) a medical director or onsite physician then performs an examination of those inmate patients who failed the screening test to identify any obvious medical reason for the failed test, e.g. earwax; (6) if the patient does not exhibit any obvious medical reason for the failed test, the inmate patient's case is then forwarded for a collegial review process; (7) the collegial review process takes place once per week and for patients who failed the screening test, the purpose of this review process is to verify that the inmate patient meets the screening criteria for further evaluation and to generate the needed authorization for paying an outside treatment provider; and (8) if the patient meets the screening criteria, the patient's name is then forwarded to a scheduler to locate a service provider and to coordinate with IDOC to schedule the audiological evaluation. Wexford confirmed that it is having difficulty locating audiologists to perform audiological evaluations. From Wexford's perspective, the audiogram testing (which is the next level hearing test) can be performed properly by either an audiologist or a Licensed Hearing Instrument Dispensaries ("LHID"). Based on this information, the court is of the opinion that the current delay the class has identified (even if it were to agree to the use of LHIDs) is caused by the collegial review process that is required by Wexford's current protocol because the demand for hearing screening has increased by more than 700% since the class settlement in this case. The court finds that IDOC must find ways to streamline the collegial review process so that the authorization for an outside referral and scheduling take place immediately after a medical finding that there is no obvious medical reason for the failed audio scope test. The reason for this finding is because the threshold for needing an audiological evaluation is finite and simple—a single "no" answer to whether an inmate patient can hear one of the three frequencies in one ear. Under these circumstances, the court further finds that the collegial review process is not warranted for those who fail the screening test and there is no obvious medical reason why they failed the test.
