ORDER

Plaintiffs moved to reinstate this action on the active docket of the court in January, 1991. Defendants' request for additional time to respond and plaintiffs' request for additional time to reply were sustained, and a September status conference was scheduled. In lieu of the conference the parties agreed that they would meet for discussion and file a status report and procedural proposals for resolving the pending matters and issues. An agreed status report was filed in October, 1991 and the parties' tendered agreed order awarding supplemental award of attorney fees was executed by the court.


In March the court scheduled a two-day hearing date on the motion to reinstate for two days in July, 1992. Thereafter the parties filed a joint motion for cancellation of the evidentiary hearing and agreed to stipulate remaining issue by July, 1992. Their agreed order provided that plaintiff would file memorandum of law by August 31, 1992, to which plaintiffs would file reply memorandum of law by October 15, 1992, at which time the matter would stand submitted.


In August, 1992 the parties agreed to file stipulation of facts by August 31, 1992, plaintiffs' briefs by August 31, defendants' response by October 15, 1992 and plaintiff's reply by October 30, 1992. To date no memoranda, briefs or pleadings have been filed.
