ORDER

Upon consideration of the application for Modification submitted by the Secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and the Warden of Louisiana State Penitentiary, and it appearing to the Court that the Application for Modification should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED that Paragraph 2.2 and Exhibit E-1 of Exhibit E of the Consent Decree be modified as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this consent decree, the Louisiana State Penitentiary is authorized to double bunk any inmates assigned to cellblocks, except those in Death Row and CCR, when ranking security staff determine such double bunking to be minimal risk to inmate safety. This revision is authorized to accommodate the rotation of inmates in cellblocks at the Louisiana State Penitentiary so that life safety code renovations can be accomplished. It will remain in effect until the renovations are completed.
