




MOTION TO MODIFY THE
INMATE DISCIPLINE POLICY
STATEMENT OF THE CONSENT DECREE

Defendants, by and through their counsel of record, John Bigelow, Special Assistant Attorney General, hereby move this Court for an order modifying the Inmate Discipline Policy Statement of the Consent Decree herein, by adding a new subsection (1) to paragraph 6, which shall read as follows:

(1) Possession, introduction, or manufacture of any contraband instrument which is capable of causing death or serious physical harm; confinement and disciplinary segregation for up to 30 days, and/or loss of good time not to exceed 180 days.

This Motion is unopposed by Plaintiffs.


