

Subject to the approval of the Court, it is hereby stipulated and agreed by and between the undersigned, attorneys of record for Plaintiffs and Defendants (together, the "Parties") in the above-entitled action (the "Action"), as follows:

1. The Stay of this action, ordered on June 13, 2017 (ECF No. 52) (the "Stay"), shall be **extended by 120 days until October 12, 2019**. This extension will allow: a.) Defendants to produce all required documents pursuant to Paragraph 5 of the Private Agreement (ECF No. 52 at 9); b.) Plaintiffs time to review these materials; and c.) Plaintiffs until 90 days prior to the expiration of the Stay to provide notice pursuant to Paragraph 3 of the Stay that they intend to reinstate the Action so that the parties can then meet and confer.

2. This Stipulation and Order may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which taken together shall constitute the Stipulation and Order, and may be executed by electronic, .pdf, or facsimile signature.
