**Opinion**

**MEMORANDUM**

McGLYNN, District Judge.

\*1 Ronald Wheeler, formerly a member of the plaintiff class has filed two papers in this action. The first is an affidavit setting forth certain facts which he contends are

inconsistent with findings made by the District Court and the Court of Appeals in the above matter. This paper did not request any relief.

Twenty days later Wheeler filed a “Motion for Correction of the Record” in which he recites the history of his own litigation in the courts of Pennsylvania and emphasizes the fact that he “never voluntarily waived his right to self-representation” (Motion p. 4).

To the extent that Wheeler wishes to have his version of the events stated on the record, he has done so by the filing of these two documents. However, because the law library aspect of the case has been settled by the parties, Wheeler’s motion is moot.

Accordingly, the motion will be denied.

**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 25th day of OCTOBER, 1990, upon consideration of the motion of Ronald Wheeler to correct the record and the affidavit in support thereof, it is

ORDERED

that the motion is DENIED as moot.
