AMENDED ORDER

On August 22, 1990 this Court entered an Order reading:

Ordered, that defendants shall not accept all persons committed by Family Court to the ACI to purge themselves of contempt until November 15, 1990.

The defendants now report to me that all such contemnors may be housed feasibly and safely in minimum security facilities rather than in the Intake Service Center (ISC) albeit initial processing of not more than twenty four hours will occur in the ISC. Since that way of handling contemnors will not add to the present overcrowded conditions in the ISC, this Court has no difficulty in accepting the procedure for handling said contemnors as suggested by the defendants. Accordingly, this Court amends the foregoing order as follows:

Ordered, that defendants may conduct intake processing in the ISC of all persons committed by Family Court to the ACI to purge themselves of contempt provided that such processing will be concluded within twenty four hours of intake and all such prisoners, following said processing, shall be housed in minimum security facilities.
