ORDER EXTENDING TEMPORARY
RESTRAINING ORDER

Plaintiffs have moved this Court for an extension of its Temporary Restraining Order of May 21, 1974, on the ground that said Order expires by its own terms four days prior to the date set for hearing on a preliminary injunction.

Upon consideration of this motion, the Court finds that:

1. There is a lapse of time during which the alleged rights of the plaintiffs are unprotected; and,
2. The status quo of the parties should be preserved pending a hearing for a preliminary injunction.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Temporary Restraining Order shall be extended until the date of the hearing for Preliminary Injunction.
