Upon plaintiffs' Application for an Order to Show Cause Why Defendant Should Not Be Held in Contempt dated December 19, 1974, this Court finds apparent violations of its Orders of August 24, 1973, November 21, 1973, and November 23, 1973, and apparant violations of its Preliminary Injunction of December 1, 1972.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the defendants have within 10 days of the effective date of this Order to admit or deny each allegation in Paragraphs 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of the Plaintiffs' Application, explaining their admissions or denials.

(2) That as to each allegation admitted pursuant to Paragraph "1" above, the defendants will explain why they should not be held in contempt.

(3) That within 5 days of the date of defendants' response, plaintiffs will inform the Court as to whether a hearing is required or what other action plaintiffs deem necessary.
