Upon Plaintiffs' Application for an Order to Show Cause Why Defendants Should Not Be Held In Contempt and for Remedial Relief, this Court finds apparent violations of its PARTIAL CONSENT DECREE, filed on January 29, 1975.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That Paragraph 4 of Plaintiffs' Application is hereby stricken on the grounds that the issues raised therein have been resolved on appeal;

(2) That a hearing is set for this matter on June 24, 1976, at 9:30 A.M., and the defendants shall respond to plaintiffs' application no later than five days prior to the date of said hearing; and

(3) That as to each allegation admitted pursuant to Paragraph 2 above, the defendants will explain why they should not be held in contempt and why they should not be required to pay attorneys' fees and costs for the plaintiffs.
