**MEMORANDUM**

CRABB, J.

\*1 Michael Wagner, an inmate at the Wisconsin Secure Program Facility, has submitted a document titled "Motion to Find Parties in Contempt of Court, Issue Sanctions, Mandate Compliance, and Civil Complaint." He asks that the motion be filed in this lawsuit. That request will be denied.

Only the parties to this lawsuit are permitted to file motions or other documents in the case for the court's consideration. Inmate Wagner is not a party to this lawsuit. If Wagner believes his constitutional rights have been violated by the failure of prison officials to give him "two pages of altered papers (cutouts), he is free to file his own lawsuit. His motion will not be considered in the context of this lawsuit.
