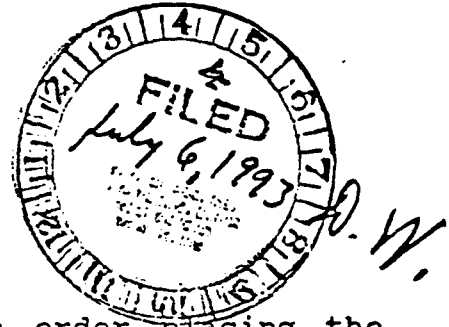

ORDER

On July 6, 1993 this court entered an order placing the Housing Authority of Kansas City, Missouri (HAKC) in receivership and appointed Joseph James, Regional Counsel for the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as the receiver of HAKC. The July 6, 1993 Order also provides that if HUD does not approve of the appointment of Joseph James, the court will appoint an alternative receiver.

Counsel for HUD informs the court that under 28 U.S.C. § 958, the court may not appoint Joseph James as a receiver because he is a United States employee. The court may, however, appoint a special master in this case. Fed. R. Civ. P. 53. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(2), and upon the consent of the parties, the Honorable Robert E. Larson, United States Magistrate Judge for the Western District of Missouri, is appointed special master pending the court's appointment of a receiver. It is therefore

ORDERED that the court RESCINDS the appointment of Joseph



James as receiver of the Housing Authority of Kansas City. It is further

ORDERED that the court APPOINTS the Honorable Robert E. Larson, United States Magistrate Judge for the Western District of Missouri, as special master pending the court's appointment of a receiver.
