17 I. INTRODUCTION

18 On September 11, 2012, the Court ordered Defendant City of Oakland ("City") to file a list
19 of all contracts it has entered into or modified since January 24, 2012, that relate, directly or
20 indirectly, to compliance under the Negotiated Settlement Agreement ("NSA"). Sept. 11, 2012
21 Order at 1.

22 For each contract, the City is ordered to identify the contractor, including a list of
23 responsible individuals if the contractor is an entity; the amount of the contract; the contract's scope
24 of work; the date the contract was entered into; and the actual or expected completion date for the
25 contracted work. Sept. 11, 2012 Order at 1-2.

1 For contracts modified since January 24, 2012, the City is ordered to identify the date on
2 which the contract was modified; any changes to the contract’s scope of work; any changes to the
3 amount of the contract; and the City’s justification for the contract’s modifications. Sept. 11, 2012
4 Order at 2.

5 For all future contract modifications and any new contracts, the City is ordered to file a
6 notice with the Court that includes the above information, along with the date on which the Chief
7 consulted with the Monitor about the contract or modification, within two business days of entering
8 into or modifying the contract. Sept. 11, 2012 Order at 2.

9 The City filed its initial response to the September 11, 2012 Order on September 21, 2012.
10 The City filed additional responses in 2012, 2013, and 2014. Most recently, the City filed an
11 additional response on September 16, 2014. The contract(s) listed below have been entered into or
12 modified since September 2014. We received notification of their execution (or pending execution)
13 and the information below within two business days of this filing.
