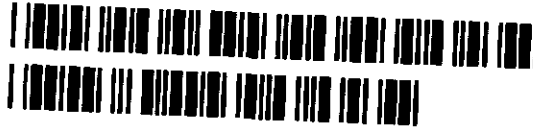

**STIPULATED MOTION TO  
AMEND ORDER APPROVING  
MERRICK BOBB AS MONITOR,  
AND ~~PROPOSED~~ ORDER**

**I. STIPULATION**

The City of Seattle and the United States of America (collectively "the Parties") entered into a Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order of Resolution ("Settlement Agreement"). On August 30, 2012, the Court entered an Order provisionally approving the Settlement Agreement (Dkt. # 8). On September 21, 2012, the Court entered the Stipulation and Order for Modification and for Entry of Preliminary Approval of the Parties' Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order of Resolution (Dkt. #13). On October 30, 2012, the Court entered the Stipulation and Order approving Merrick Bobb as Monitor (Dkt. # 35). On November 14, 2012, the Court approved the Monitor's first year budget.

1 It has become necessary to clarify that the Monitor is not paid in his personal capacity but  
2 rather as an employee of his employer, the Police Assessment Resource Center (PARC).  
3 Merrick Bobb is a salaried employee of PARC. All amounts billed and received for monitoring  
4 are assets of PARC and not of Merrick Bobb.

5 The Parties, by and through their counsel of record, hereby STIPULATE, AGREE, and  
6 JOINTLY REQUEST that the Court amend its Order approving Merrick Bobb as Monitor  
7 (Dkt. # 35), retroactive to October 30, 2012, appointing Merrick Bobb as Monitor to read:

8 “[I]t is now hereby ORDERED that the Court approves of the Parties’ selection of  
9 Merrick Bobb, as employee of the Police Assessment Resource Center (PARC),  
10 to serve as Monitor under the Settlement Agreement.”

II. ~~PROPOSED~~ ORDER
