**STIPULATED MOTION**

On October 24, 2013, the Community Police Commission (“CPC”) moved to intervene for the purpose of proposing modifications to deadlines in Appendix A to the Monitoring Plan for the First Year (“Monitoring Plan”) and the Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”). Dkt. No. 90 (“Motion to Intervene”).

On October 30, 2013, the City and the CPC separately moved this Court for extensions of certain deadlines in the Monitoring Plan and MOU. Dkt. Nos. 91 & 92 respectively (“Motions for Extension”).

1 On November 5, 2013, in accordance with the Court's Order entered that same day (Dkt.  
2 No. 95), the United States filed a consolidated response to the Motion to Intervene and the Motions  
3 for Extension. Dkt. No. 96. Pursuant to Local Civil Rules 7(d)(2) and 7(d)(3), the reply briefs of  
4 the City and the CPC are currently due November 8, 2013.

5 The parties and CPC are currently exploring possible alternatives to intervention by the  
6 CPC, and would benefit from additional time to continue to discuss these issues. To allow for this  
7 additional time, the parties wish to extend the noting date for the Motion to Intervene and the  
8 Motions for Extension from November 8 to November 13, 2013.

9 The parties therefore respectfully move this Court to extend the noting date for the Motion  
10 to Intervene and the Motions for Extension until November 13, 2013. Under this schedule, pursuant  
11 to Local Civil Rules 7(d)(2) and 7(d)(3), the reply briefs of the City and the CPC in support of these  
12 motions would be due on November 13, 2013.
