O R D E R

This Court has received and considered the Joint Motion of the Board of Education ("Board") and the United States filed July 25, 1983 and the oral arguments of counsel for the parties on July 26, 1983. It is hereby ORDERED that:

1. This Court's further hearing scheduled for 2:00 p.m. August 10, 1983 (see June 30 Order ¶6) is rescheduled to 8:00 a.m. September 12, 1983.
2. Board's date for submission of the Educational Components portion of its 1983 Annual Desegregation Review is extended to August 29, 1983.
3. In light of the foregoing schedule changes, and in light of this Court's Order permitting funding to the Title IV and Special Programs grantees through September 30, 1983, the direction to the United States and the Secretary of Education to refrain until August 10, 1983, from expending or further obligating certain funds (see June 30 Order ¶3(a)), is extended from August 10 to September 30, 1983.

Counsel for Board and the United States are directed to confer concerning the provision of June 30 Order ¶2, which calls for a final report by the United States on August 8, 1983 detailing its efforts and progress in implementing the affirmative program to find and provide funding for Board, and to advise the Court of their views.
