JUDGMENT


Considering the "Motion for Declaration of Partial Unitary Status as to Student Activities" (Document No. 191); the "Amended Motion for Declaration of Partial Unitary Status as to Student Activities" (Document No. 199); the "Motion to Submit Majorette and Cheerleader Policy as to Student Activities" (Document No. 205); the "Amended Motion to Submit Amended Majorette and Cheerleader Policy as to Student Activities" (Document No. 210) (all filed by the Avoyelles Parish School Board); any related filings; the evidence adduced at the August 24, 2012 hearing; the reasons set forth in Open Court on that date; no further objection having been filed since the most recent Amended Motion was submitted; and the Court being satisfied that in granting this Judgment it is unlikely the school district will revert to its former ways by any attempt to reestablish a dual system in the area of extracurricular activities,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Avoyelles Parish School District is declared unitary in the area of extracurricular activities.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that all outstanding orders and injunctions herein, in the measure that they apply to the area of extracurricular activities, are hereby dissolved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court's supervision over the operations of the Avoyelles Parish School District in the area of extracurricular activities is hereby relinquished and fully terminated.
