AFFIDAVIT OF JULIA TOLIVER MILLER

Julia Toliver Miller, being first duly sworn, says:

I live at 1304 Opalousas Street, Lake Charles, Louisiana. I am a practical nurse. I work part of the time at St. Patrick's Hospital in Lake Charles but I also work outside the hospital for private persons. I was born in St. Landry Parish, Louisiana, and am 50 years old. I have finished the eight grade.

On March 12, 1962, I went to the Southwest Louisiana Vocational-Technical School to see about registering for a course in practical nursing. I had read in the American Press, which is a daily newspaper in Lake Charles, that such a course was being offered at the school. I got there around 2:00 p.m. I talked to Mrs. Vivian Langley who was in the registrar's office about making application for the course I wanted to take. Mrs. Langley said that the school was not accepting applications for practical nursing. I asked her if I could talk to the director of the school and she said she would check with him. She went into another office and when she came back she said the director was busy and couldn't see me. When I told her that I had read in the paper that they were giving the

course she said there must have been some misunderstanding about the article. I asked her if there was any chance of my applying later and she said she didn't know. I then left the school and haven't been back.

I would still like to take a course in practical nursing at Southwest Louisiana Trade School and would like to make out an application for the course.
