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SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT OF THE JONES COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Jones County School District, by and through the Jones County School Board voted to sell the Pendorff Elementary School Property. The School Board authorized notice to bidders who were interested in purchasing the property and that the advertisement was published in *The Laurel Leader-Call* on August 13, August 20, and August 27, 2013. One bid was submitted in response to the advertisement and that bid was from R W Properties, LLC to purchase the entire property "as is" for \$150,125.00. The Board Attorney contacted the Justice Department and the United States Department of Justice had no objection to the District's sale of the unused school facility. A copy of the email from Joseph J. Wardenski, Trial Attorney, U. S. Department of Justice, Civil Rights Division is attached to this Report as Exhibit "A." A copy of the letter to Zoe Savitsky requesting approval with the documents attached are also attached to this report as Exhibit "B."

The School Board accepted the bid and authorized the President, Secretary, and Superintendent of Education to sign the deed to R W Properties, LLC. All voted for the motion.
