This report shall state the race of the teacher employed to fill each such vacancy and indicate whether such teacher is newly employed or was transferred from within the system and shall indicate the schools from which and to which the transfers were made. The report shall also set forth the number of faculty members of each race assigned to each school for the current year. The defendant shall serve upon opposing counsel within thirty (30) days after opening of schools, and file copies with the Court, a report setting forth the above.
