IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED

In accordance with the decision of the United States Supreme Court in this case, Parents
Involved in Community Schools v. Seattle School District No. 1 et al., 127 S. Ct. 2738 (2007); the
judgment of the Supreme Court entered on July 28, 2007 (remanding this case to the Court of
Appeals for the Ninth Circuit for further proceedings); and the Judgment of the Court of Appeals
entered on August 22, 2007 (remanding the case to this court for further proceedings); and based
upon the reasoning of the Supreme Court in its aforesaid decision, the court hereby:

- 1. vacates its April 6, 2001 grant of summary judgment in favor of Defendant, Seattle School
District No. 1;
2. grants, in part, Plaintiff, Parents Involved in Community Schools' Motion for Entry of Judgment;
3. denies Plaintiff's Motion for Entry of Judgment insofar as it seeks injunctive or declaratory
relief;
4. denies the District's Cross Motion for Dismissal; and

5. finds that Plaintiff is a prevailing party as that term is used in the Civil Rights Attorney's Fees Awards Act, 42 U.S.C. § 1988, but declines, at this juncture, to declare that PICS is entitled to an award of attorney's fees.
