Rule 1S-2.042(3)(c); vii. Rule 1S-2.042(3)(d); viii. Rule 1S-2.042(3)(e), to the extent it requires disclosure of volunteer registration agents or their termination; ix. Rule 1S-2.042(4)(b), to the extent it requires recording the time of collection of any voter registration applications; x. Rule 1S-2.042(5); xi. Rule 1S-2.042(6)(a), to the extent it requires an accounting of the number of voter registration forms provided to or held by a third party voter registration organization; xii.
