However, given the Defendants' explanation that these documents are "confidential, settlement–related materials that the DTA generated solely in connection with the July 5 Agreement,... and to facilitate discussions regarding the settlement of the remainder of the case," D. 50 at 9, and that the Defendants have declined to produce them as public records in response to third–party requests, D. 50 at 11, the Court cannot agree that they are public records or are "publicly available." To the extent that Plaintiffs seek a modification of the Protective Order, the Court finds no good cause for such modification. <u>See</u> Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(c); <u>Public Citizen v. Liggett Group, Inc.</u> , 858 F.2d 775, 790 (1st Cir. 1988). For all these reasons, the Court DENIES the motion.
