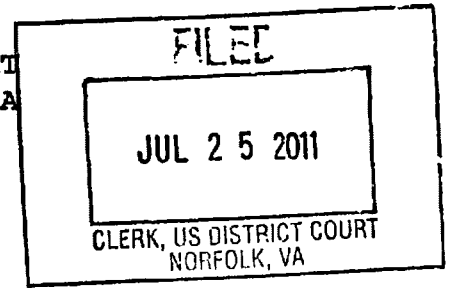

ORDER

On July 25, 2011, the defendants filed a Motion to Stay Judgment, which requests that the court stay its July 20, 2011, judgment pending appeal to the Fourth Circuit under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 62(c). This case now comes before the court on defendants' July 25, 2011, Motion for Expedited Ruling on the Motion to Stay Judgment. The defendants request an expedited ruling on their Motion to Stay Judgment before the 14-day period passed under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 62(a), after which the Plaintiff may seek to enforce this court's July 20, 2011 Opinion.¹ In consideration of the need to expeditiously consider the relief requested, and for good cause
